

# Call for Copy Editor - Xjenza Online

The **Malta Chamber of Scientists** invites applications for the position of **Copy Editor** for *Xjenza Online*, Malta's peer-reviewed open-access journal for science and technology.

*Xjenza Online* publishes high-quality research articles, reviews, and perspectives that promote scientific communication within the Maltese and international research community.

# **Role and Responsibilities**

The Copyeditor will:

- Ensure that submitted manuscripts are correctly formatted in **LaTeX**, including consistency of references, cross-referencing, figures, and tables.
- Check that all submissions conform to *Xjenza*'s author guidelines and maintain stylistic consistency across articles.
- Communicate with the Editor-in-Chief and Editorial Board in a **timely and professional manner** to address any formatting or technical issues.
- Convert manuscripts submitted in Word format to LaTeX where required.
- Contact the corresponding authors of the manuscripts to approve the proofs.
- Carry out final checks on typeset articles before publication.
- Register the DOIs of the published manuscripts on MEDRA.

# Requirements

- A good grasp of **LaTeX** and familiarity with academic publishing conventions.
- Strong attention to detail and an eye for consistency in layout and referencing.
- Ability to meet deadlines and work collaboratively with the editorial team.

### Remuneration

The selected individual will receive a €650 honorarium per issue. Each issue typically contains 6–8 papers, and there are two or three issues per year.
